<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ISSUE / TOPIC</u></p> <p>We request that rubbish bins be placed (and serviced) along the routes taken by most students between the Fish Hoek Train Station and False Bay College, Fish Hoek Campus. This is to aid the students that seem incapable of carrying their rubbish (chip packets, etc.) with them to their destination. The increased litter is not only unsightly, but clogs our stormwater system resulting in this rubbish being dumped on our beaches, if they don't block the stormwater system. One route student traverses along Central Road to Central Circle while the other cuts through the Fish Hoek Arcade to First Avenue. Both routes join at different places on Recreation Road.
